<p>Presentation Overview:</p>	<p>Westfield Group, one of the world's largest retail shopping centre organisations has implemented an automated Global Safety Reporting (GSR) system.</p> <p>Operating on a global platform, the Westfield Group is an internally managed, vertically integrated shopping centre group, undertaking ownership, development, design, construction, funds and asset management, property management, leasing and marketing.</p> <p>Westfield manages a portfolio of 119 shopping centres and numerous construction projects in Australia, New Zealand, the United Kingdom and the United States, valued in excess of A\$62 billion and employing around 4,000 staff worldwide. The Global Safety Reporting system allows Westfield to automate the consolidation of Life Safety data with associated workflow and to produce a variety of management reports.</p> <p>Westfield collaborated with Australian software group, integrum, to develop the system which now provides transparency and accountability to all levels within the Westfield Group.</p>			
<p>Keynote Speaker:</p>	<p>Phil Tanner General Manager – Life Safety Westfield</p> <p>Phil joined the Westfield Group 16 years ago on a major redevelopment. Since then he has developed and implemented the Life Safety framework and systems for all parts of the business. Phil is currently the General Manager of Life Safety, reporting to the Chief Risk Officer. He has responsibility for the management of Life Safety aspects of Westfield operations of which the global consolidation and reporting on Life Safety for the Group form a part of his role.</p> <p>His responsibilities take him throughout Australia and overseas to coordinate the Global Safety Reporting activities throughout the various operating divisions of the Westfield Group.</p>
